

## Indoor competitions: Rules

All rounds have play by dates with the exception of the final.

Rules:-

- The player whose name appears first (on top) is designated the Challenger, the second is designated the Opponent.
- The Challenger is responsible for agreeing the date, time and booking the rink (and marker for singles)
- The Challenger shall offer his/her Opponent the choice of 3 dates, one or two on weekdays, one or two on weekends.
- **The Challenger must offer dates to the Opponent within 5 days of the end of the PREVIOUS ROUND.**
- In the case of the opening round contact should be made no later than 10 days prior to the closing date of that round.
- Weekend ties shall not commence before 10am.
- Evening ties to commence 6pm or 8pm.
- Once dates have been offered, an arrangement must be agreed within 72 hours.
- If the Opponent has arranged to play another competition on any of the dates offered, the Challenger must provide alternative dates.
- **If the Challenger fails to offer 3 dates within the given time frame then the Opponent shall offer 3 dates**
- If an agreement cannot be reached on date and time then the tie will be arranged by the Competition Secretary
- ALL games MUST be played by the play by date.
- All finals will be played on Finals Day
- Rink fees are payable for all competition rounds except the final.
